

1 **MINUTES** of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida **SPECIAL**  
2 **MEETING/PUBLIC HEARING** on the Fiscal Year 2006/2007 budget, held on Wednesday,  
3 September 13, 2006, at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, 201 N. Holly Avenue, Orange City.

5 **CALL TO ORDER**

6  
7 The Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Erwin and roll call was taken.  
8

9 **ROLL CALL**

11 **PRESENT:** Mayor Albert T. Erwin; Vice Mayor Chuck Abell; Council Members Anthony R.

17 The City Council and the audience joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

19 **1. MAYOR'S OPENING COMMENTS:**

20  
21 Mayor Erwin read the following statement into the record: "The City of Orange City  
22 intends to adopt a budget and millage rate for Fiscal Year 2006/2007. The proposed  
23 millage rate is 4.87506 mills which reflects a 19.88% increase over the roll-back rate of  
24 4.06661 as provided by the Property Appraiser of Volusia County."  
25

26 **2. PUBLIC HEARING - FIRST READING**

27  
28 **A. ORDINANCE NO. 281:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida,  
29 certifying the millage rate for fiscal year 2006-2007 on all taxable property located  
30 within the City of Orange City, Volusia County, Florida; containing a repealer  
31 provision; a severability clause and providing for an effective date.  
32

33 Mayor Erwin read the title of Ordinance No. 281 into the record and opened the public hearing  
34 by asking if anyone wished to speak in favor of or in opposition to the proposed ordinance. No  
35 one appeared. The Mayor closed the public hearing.  
36

37 **B. ORDINANCE NO. 282:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida,  
38 adopting the annual budget for the 2006-2007 fiscal year beginning October 1,  
39 2006, and ending September 30, 2007; authorizing subsequent amendments by  
40 resolution; repealing all inconsistent ordinances or parts thereof; and providing for  
41 an effective date.  
42

43 Mayor Erwin read the title of Ordinance No. 282 into the record and opened the public hearing  
44 by asking if anyone wished to speak in favor of or in opposition to the proposed ordinance. No  
45 one appeared. The Mayor closed the public hearing.  
46

47 **C. STAFF PRESENTATIONS**  
48

1 Mr. McCue referenced a memorandum that was given to Council (a copy of which is attached  
2 and becomes a permanent part of these minutes). He noted revisions to the proposed budget  
3 subsequent to Council discussion at the Budget Workshop as follows, an increase of \$25,000 in  
4 legal funding, and an increase of \$120,000 in road and drainage construction for repaving of  
5 Holly Avenue. In addition, staff recommended changes to the Equipment and Vehicle line items  
6 due to a \$36,000 grant from DOT (Department of Transportation) awarded to the City for the  
7 purchase of a new police vehicle; an addition of \$25,000 to replace outdated fiber optic lines and  
8 an additional \$20,000 for new report writing software for the Police Department.

#### 9 10 **D. PUBLIC HEARING**

11  
12 The public hearing was held previously following the reading of the titles of Ordinance Numbers  
13 281 and 282 and prior to staff's presentation. There were no further requests from the public to  
14 speak.

18 (1) Millage Ordinance is voted on:

20 **Vice Mayor Abell moved to adopt Ordinance No. 281 on first**  
21 **reading, seconded by Council Member Yebba and passed by**  
22 **unanimous 6/0 roll call vote of the Council.**

24 (2) Budget Ordinance is voted on:

26 **Council Member Yebba moved to adopt Ordinance No. 282 on**  
27 **first reading, seconded by Vice Mayor Abell and passed by**  
28 **unanimous 6/0 roll call vote of the Council.**

#### 29 30 **F. ANNOUNCEMENT OF PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE.**

31  
32 Mayor Erwin read the following statement into the record.

33  
34 The proposed millage rate for the City of Orange City for Fiscal Year 2006-2007 is 4.87506  
35 mills which represents a 19.88% increase over the roll-back rate of 4.06661 as provided by the  
36 Property Appraiser of Volusia County.
