4. ORDINANCES - FIRST READING:

- A. Ordinance No. 314: An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida, annexing the McKeen property into the corporate limits of the City of Orange City, Florida; said property being generally located on the north side of East Iris Drive approximately 300 feet east of South Volusia Avenue, containing approximately 0.24 acres; in accordance with the voluntary annexation provisions of Florida Statute 171.044; redefining the boundaries of the City of Orange City by amending the appropriate sections of the code of ordinances; containing a repealer provision, a severability clause and providing for an effective date.

5. PUBLIC HEARINGS/ORDINANCES – SECOND & FINAL READING:

- A. **ORDINANCE NO. 304:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida, amending Chapter 8 Licenses, Section 8-13 Taxes Specified, by revising the fee schedule set forth in Section 8-13; containing a severability clause, a repealer provision, and providing for an effective date.

- B. **ORDINANCE NO. 313:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, amending Section 10.2, Distribution of Handbills and Circulars, of Chapter 10, Offenses-Miscellaneous; providing for repeal of Section 10.2(B), providing for new Sections to address distributing of handbills to a receptacle or under the door mat, providing that citizens may place a sign declining the distribution of handbills and circulars; providing for severability, codification, and providing an effective date.

- A. **RESOLUTION NO. 407-07:** A resolution of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida, to adopt Map “A” as presented and accepted by the Volusia Council of Governments (VCOG) Smart Growth Committee as environmentally sensitive lands conserved for future generations.
