ORDINANCE NO. 425:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida, imposing a temporary moratorium for 180 days on the issuance of any business tax license, permit, conditional use approval, site plan approval and any other official action of the City of Orange City having the effect of permitting or allowing the construction and/or operation of certain businesses within the City of Orange City, related to game rooms, arcades, internet cafes, sweepstakes redemption centers, establishments using slot machines or slot machine like equipment and similar indoor entertainment and amusement activities as

more specifically described in this ordinance, excluding approvals and permits for the continuance of an existing business; the temporary moratorium shall apply to all real property located within the corporate limits of the City of Orange City; providing a procedure for extraordinary hardship; providing for severability, conflicts, and an effective date.
