- A. **ORDINANCE NO. 448:** An ordinance of the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida, amending Sections of Chapter 17.3 Utilities of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Orange City, Florida; providing for conflicts, severability and effective date.
- B. **ORDINANCE NO. 450:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Volusia County, Florida; amending Orange City code Appendix A, Zoning Ordinance as adopted by Ordinance No. 157, amending Section 3.6 Variances adding 3.6.6 Administrative Variances; containing a repealer provision, severability clause and providing for an effective date.

6. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

- A. **ORDINANCE NO. 447:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida, annexing the Senez property into the corporate limits of the City of Orange City, Florida; said property being generally located on the west side of North Volusia Avenue, approximately 600 feet south of West Minnesota Avenue, containing approximately 9.35 acres; in accordance with the voluntary annexation provisions of Florida Statute 171.044; redefining the boundaries of the City of Orange City by amending the appropriate sections of the code of ordinances; containing a repealer provision, a severability clause and providing for an effective date.
- B. **ORDINANCE NO. 449:** An ordinance of the City of Orange City, Florida, extending a temporary moratorium for an additional ninety (90) days on the issuance of any business tax license, permit, conditional use approval, site plan approval, and any other official action of the City of Orange City having the effect of permitting or allowing construction and/or operations of certain businesses within the City of Orange City, related to game rooms, arcades, internet cafes, sweepstakes redemption centers, establishments using slot machines or slot machine like equipment and similar indoor entertainment and amusement activities as more specifically described in this ordinance, excluding approvals and permits for the continuance of an existing business; the temporary moratorium shall apply to all real property located within the corporate limits of the City of Orange City; providing for conflicting provisions; providing for severability, conflicts and an effective date.
